



The Tay Estuary Forum have recently launched a five- year Management Plan: a non-statutory document aimed at promoting future sustainable management in the Tay Estuary and along the adjacent coastline. The plan was drafted over 2008/9 following discussions at the annual TEF conference and a period of consultation, attracting input from a wide range of stakeholders and individuals.

The Management Plan covers the region from the River North Esk on the Angus Coast to Fife Ness; including the Tay Estuary to Scone. It aims to unite the many initiatives operating along this diverse stretch of coast into a sustainable framework, ensuring future vitality of the region.
